

LD 993 would create a Maine Forest Advisory Board to advise the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry on a variety of forestry issues. Right now, the industry is the only big voice on forest issues of Maine! Reach out to the chairs of ACF (including UU Bill Pluecker) to urge them to support it, or email your legislators to urge them to vote for this bill when it comes to the floor.
