host in February or March, just send me an email.

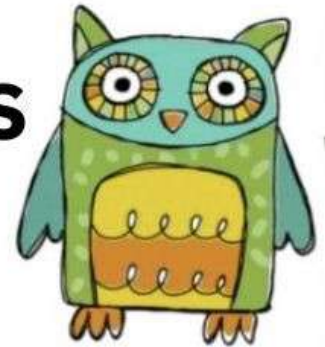
